The lineage of chiefs listed herein is based on the McQueens of Corrybrough, of Clan Chattan, which seems to be the only branch discussed in the published sources referenced below. Other branches may exist distinct from the Corrybrough branch.

The lineage presented up to Donald Robert McQueen is based on two published sources:

W. & A.K. Johnston Ltd (with acknowledgement to Whyte, Henry) (1907) *The Scottish Clans and their Tartans*, 9th Edition, The musson Book Company, Toronto.

Nydegger, James Archibald (1928), *The MacQueens, being a brief history of the origin of the MacQueen family, with special reference to the MacQueens of Corrybrough* Meyer & Thalheimer, Baltimore.

On the death of Donald Robert McQueen in 1925, the title of chief should have passed to William Alastair McQueen, and on his death in 1976, to his son John Alexander McQueen.

Endnotes:

¹ The spelling McQueen is used for consistency, and is not intended to differentiate between MacQueen and McQueen

² only one of five sons of Lauchlan to marry; emigrated to NZ, worked as manager of Cheviot Station near Christchurch. Predeceased his brother Donald Robert McQueen.

³ By succession, should have assumed the chiefship on the death of Donald Robert McQueen, his uncle, in 1925, and held it until his death in 1976.

⁴ By succession, should have assumed the chiefship in 1976 on the death of his father. Formerly manager with Bank of New Zealand, currently resident at Ohope Beach, Whakatane, NZ.

⁵ Only son of John Alexander McQueen, and next in hereditary line for chiefship. Presently resident in Mindalton, Victoria, Australia

⁶ Lived in Christchurch, NZ
